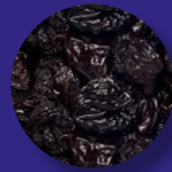

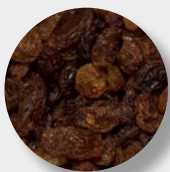

From the South of France, we offer the Prune d'Agen - celebrated for its naturally soft texture and deep fruity taste, with a moisture content of 33%.

We source a wide variety of raisins to have a year-round stable supply and be able to offer different flavours and colour profiles.

We source our Flame and Blue Thompson raisins from the hills and valleys of North Argentina, our Sultana raisins from the Manisa region in Turkey and our Currants from Greece. All our raisins are sundried at the end of the summer on the plains bordering the vineyards. We regularly visit our suppliers factories and vineyards, to understand their practices, share insights and strengthen our connection.

Harvested at peak ripeness and gently dried, the fruit retains its natural sweetness and rich tropical aroma. We offer various cuts, perfectly suited for snacking, retail packs and fruit mixes.

Mango insight

Organic mango has a short, two-month harvest window. Once picked, the fruit ripens rapidly - meaning peeling, slicing and drying must take place within days to prevent spoilage. The season start with the sweet sour Amélie variety in May, followed by Lippens and Kent in June and finishing with Brooks in July. Early planning is essential, as availability can vary from season to season.

Canada's cool climate and clean water provide the perfect conditions for growing flavourful organic cranberries. Carefully dried and lightly sweetened - with either organic cane sugar or apple juice - to balance their natural tartness. Ideal for use in cereal mixes, baked goods or snacks.

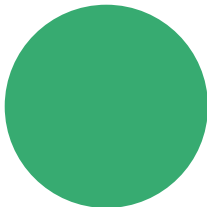

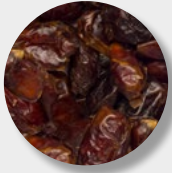
